**NEW: Hospital Choice:** Pays up to \$2000 for your first night's stay in the hospital. Covers hospital stays for both injury and illness. There are additional benefits for doctors' visits, diagnostic tests, and surgery. **Special benefits for maternity.**

**Accident Advantage:** Pays you cash for expenses related to injuries you or your family incur. You do not have to miss work to receive payment. Increased benefits for most injuries and an **additional 25% for injuries resulting from organized sporting events and at a lower, compared to some of our current plans.** \$60 annual wellness benefit.

**Critical Illness Rider:** Pays you cash benefits up to \$5000 in the event of a catastrophic health event such as Heart Attack, Stroke and others, including Lyme Disease! Can be added to Accident, Hospital or Short Term Disability.

**Cancer Care:** up to \$10,000 for first occurrence of internal cancer as well on-going payments for treatments, surgery, travel and hospital stays. Annual screening benefit.

**Life Insurance:** Whole life or 10, 20 or 30, year term coverage up to \$500,000.
